WHO IS TRULY HAPPY?

In the Gospel this Sunday we hear the beginning Jesus' Sermon on the Mount. It opens with one of the Lord's best known teachings - the eight Beatitudes. These statements teach us who it is that God considers to be truly happy and blessed, what his priorities are and what our aims in life should be. They have sometimes been described as Jesus' manifesto, his vision of the kingdom of God.

As we listen to them we are both comforted *and* challenged. The Lord tells us that God is especially close to the poor, the humble and those who are suffering. But he's also letting us know that we need to be willing to make sacrifices and to stand up for our faith and for what is right. May God help us to do that this week!

WEDNESDAY: ST BRIGID'S DAY

THURSDAY: CANDLEMAS

Thursday is the feast of the Presentation of the Lord. It is also known as Candlemas because Mass begins with a blessing of candles and a procession to the altar. There will be Mass at **7pm**. Blessed hand candles will be available at Mass and you are welcome to bring any candles of your own which you wish to have blessed.
