Bishop Alan is a native of Cloughmills and a past pupil of St Macnissi's, Garron Tower. He joined the Jesuit order in 1972 and was ordained a priest in 1984. Over the years he has worked in education and communication ministries and from 2011 he served as director of the Down & Connor Living Church office. In 2017 he was appointed Bishop of Raphoe in County Donegal. As a parish we send Bishop Alan our prayers and best wishes at this time of change for him. ## SAFEGUARDING SUNDAY

Bishop Donal McKeown has published a pastoral letter this weekend on Safeguarding. He writes "On this particular Safeguarding Sunday, I as Apostolic Administrator, draw your attention to the publication of the National Board Report on Safeguarding Practice in the Diocese of Down and Connor.

My thoughts go to those who have experienced abuse within our Church and who carry with them the scars of their experience. I hope this Report would give you some solace. As a Diocese, Down and Connor will strive to ensure that their experience in the past will not be repeated in the future. We continue to owe victims and their families a duty of care with compassion and healing in their spiritual and personal lives.

The conclusion of the Report states that the Diocese of Down and Connor, 'has a strong Safeguarding structure, which promotes and delivers on engagement with and support for parishes and their Safeguarding personnel.' The Report goes on to say, 'None of this would be possible without the commitment and dedication the Reviewers witnessed from people at all levels.'

Here in our family of parishes the new Safeguarding Committee is doing great work to make sure we continue to look after children and vulnerable adults in our community. Thank you to the volunteers who represent our parish in this important ministry.
