## JESUS LAYS DOWN THE LAW

In today's Gospel Jesus takes over from Moses as the one who brings the law of God to earth. As he says, he is not replacing the Ten Commandments of the Old Testament but revealing what lies behind those laws - love.

In fact that makes the law of Jesus even more demanding. And the examples he gives here about how we apply God's law to our relationships are very strict. But the law of love is also merciful. God knows we are not perfect so he gives us not just a law, but also his mercy when we break it. May we follow God's laws to the best of our abilities and seek his forgiveness when we fail. By his grace we will then be worthy of his kingdom.
