The pharisees regard it as another reason to have Jesus killed. Despite the miracle they have no faith.

Lent is the time for us to grow in faith and open our eyes to the glory of God. So as we reach the halfway point of Lent this year, let's make even more effort to love God and our neighbour, and to use this time well.
