THE FORGIVENESS OF SINS

We have reached the fifth Sunday of Lent and the beginning of Passiontide, the last part of this penitential season. Our thoughts increasingly turn to the death and resurrection of Jesus. In the Church our statues and crosses are veiled until the great Easter Vigil ceremony.

One vital preparation for Easter is to make sure we've been to confession and had our sins forgiven. In the Gospel Jesus teaches the Jews how God's mercy extends both to those who have sinned publicly (like the woman caught in adultery) and those whose sins are in their



hearts (like the pharisees). God knows how we too have sinned and he longs to forgive us and restore us to holiness. Let's receive the grace he offers us in confession so that we can be holy and happy for Easter!

LENT DEVOTIONS

Stations of the Cross and **Benediction** will be prayed on Tuesday at **7pm**.

On **Wednesday** at **7pm** we will have another **Taizé** prayer service for Lent. This is a time of prayer with scripture readings, periods of silent meditation and simple chanted hymns. It is a chance to experience a more reflective style of worship.

MASS IN DERVOCK

EARLY MORNING MASS IN COLERAINE

Each **weekday of Lent** an early morning Mass is celebrated at **7am** in **St Malachy's** in **Coleraine** for our Causeway Family of Parishes. This Mass is being organised jointly by the priests of Coleraine, Ballymoney and Portstewart. Fr Damian will be saying the Mass on Tuesday this week.

Next Sunday (13th) is Palm Sunday. Our 9.30am Mass is the monthly *Do This In Memory* Mass and we invite all the children present to take part in the palm procession at the start of Mass. After Mass children and their families are invited over to the parish hall for easter arts and crafts (and there will be refreshments for parents and family too!).
