Bishop Alan is taking on the work of being our shepherd, our teacher and our father in faith.

INSTALLATION OF BISHOP McGUCKIAN

On Sunday at 3pm the Most Rev. Alan McGuckian will be installed as Bishop of Down & Connor at St Peter's Cathedral in Belfast. During the Mass there are three special moments:

- The new Bishop is met at the door of the Cathedral by representatives of the clergy and lay people of the diocese who formally welcome him.
- The Papal mandate is read, confirming Bishop Alan's appointment to Down & Connor by Pope Francis.
- The Bishop takes his place at his *cathedra* (the Bishop's throne) for the first time. This represents his authority as chief teacher of the faith for our diocese.

Each parish and ministry of the diocese will be sending representatives to the Mass as will each secondary level school. Our parish will be represented by Fr Damian and by Susan Hargan and Barbara Hegarty from the Parish Pastoral Council. Sr Rosemary Gallagher will be representing the Causeway Hospital chaplaincy team.

The Mass will be available to watch on the Cathedral webcam through churchservices.tv, and on the Down & Connor Facebook page.
