THE LORD WALKS ALONGSIDE US



In the Gospel today we hear the beautiful account of how the risen Jesus appeared to the two disciples on the road to Emmaus. These men had left Jerusalem because they couldn't face staying on following the death of Jesus. They had heard stories about the empty tomb, but they didn't believe.

The Lord, however, was walking right there beside them in their sadness, though they couldn't see it was him. But when they listened to him speak in the scriptures, and saw him break the bread for them, they finally recognised he was with them. Jesus wants to reassure us too that he walks beside us all through our lives. And when we listen to his Word and share in his Eucharist at Mass we realise that the Lord is indeed always with us.

MAY COURSE - THE SEVEN JOYS OF MARY

During May, the month of Mary, the parish will be running a course called The Seven Joys of Mary. Over five weeks, this programme will give us a chance to reflect on the joys of Mary's life and how we can draw comfort from them and make a connection between our own faith journey and Our Lady's.

The Seven Joys of Mary are:

- The Annunciation & Visitation
- The birth of Jesus
- The adoration of the Magi
- The resurrection of Jesus
- The Ascension of Jesus into heaven and the descent of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost
- The Assumption of Mary into heaven.
- The crowning of Mary as Queen of heaven.

Each week we'll reflect on what scripture says about these mysteries and learn how to pray about them more deeply. We'll finish by praying a decade of the rosary together.

DOWN & CONNOR LOURDES PILGRIMAGE

The Diocesan Pilgrimage to Lourdes will run in July this year. Our pilgrimage includes the celebration of Masses, including at the Grotto; celebration of the Sacrament of the Sick and Reconciliation; participation in the Blessed Sacrament and candlelight processions and the Way of the Cross. There is plenty of free time for your own personal prayer, to relax, and to explore the town of Lourdes.

Five night pilgrimages (12th-17th July) cost £769 and six nights (11th-17th July) £829. Fares are inclusive of return flights from Belfast International Airport, transfers from and to Lourdes Airport, full-board accommodation, courier services and other taxes. A deposit of £200 per person is required at the time of booking, with the balance payable approximately 8 weeks before departure.
