POPE FRANCIS 1936-2025

It is with great sadness that we learned of the death of our Holy Father Pope Francis on Monday. Just the day before we were delighted to see the Holy Father deliver his *Urbi et Orbi* blessing for Easter Sunday. Although we all knew he had been very ill, his sudden death on Monday morning was still a great shock.

At Mass that morning Fr Damian read from the Pope's Easter message: "The Lord now lives forever. He fills us with the certainty that we too are called to share in the life that knows no end." This is the hope that we take from Easter into the rest of our lives. May Pope Francis, the preacher of hope, now enter into that eternal life and the kingdom of heaven.
