For this reason our diocese is undertaking a programme of planning called Pathways to the Future. A steering team of lay men, women and clergy has been preparing for this in recent months and representatives of our parish have taken part in initial conversations. In the

coming months we will all have a chance to find out more and play our part. This is a time of rebuilding and renewal for our Diocese and we enter it with confidence that the Holy Spirit, sent to us by the Father, will guide us on our journey together.

This week we'll be looking at the visit of the Magi and what that meant for Mary. We'll listen to readings and spend some time in quiet prayer, ending with a decade of the rosary. It's a lovely chance to spend some quiet time with Jesus and Mary during the month of Our Lady. The same session will also run on Friday at the Marian Hall in Portstewart at 10am.

MASS TIME CHANGE

At the start of July there will be a number of changes to Mass times in the Causeway Coast area. As less priests are available there is a need to coordinate times across parishes so that Masses can still be covered even when some of the local priests are away. This also allows us to offer a range of different Mass times across the parishes of Ballymoney, Coleraine, Portrush and Portstewart.

As part of these changes, it will be necessary for Ballymoney's Sunday morning Mass to move to an earlier time so that one priest can celebrate Mass in both Ballymoney and Coleraine or Portrush when required. Our Saturday 6pm and Sunday 5pm Masses will not change.

Before we make a change, our Parish Pastoral Council would like to ask you what time would you prefer for our Sunday morning Mass - 9am or 9.30am. We will also take particular account of the views of those who help out at Mass as readers, ministers of Holy Communion, Children's Liturgy and choir.


HYMNS FOR MASS
