Fifth Sunday of Easter



MARY SHOWS US HOW TO LOVE LIKE JESUS

This Sunday's Gospel reminds us of Jesus's call to "love one another as I have loved you." But Jesus isn't talking about sentimental feelings but tough, active love—the kind that rolls up sleeves and helps others in need.

Mary, his mother, perfectly exemplified this love. She didn't just pray—she journeyed to help her pregnant cousin Elizabeth, supported Jesus's disciples, and comforted them after his death. That's why this May, our parish is honouring Mary differently. While we still crown her statue and offer flowers, we're also inviting everyone to perform acts of kindness in her honour. These will be offered during Friday's May crowning Mass—living bouquets showing that, like Mary, we love through action.
