This weekend the Church celebrates its birthday. Pentecost marks the moment when the apostles received the gift of the Holy Spirit and were empowered to go out and share the Gospel with others.



With that in mind, Bishop Donal McKeown, the apostolic administrator of our diocese, has written a pastoral letter to us (Fr Damian will read some excerpts from it at our Masses). Bishop McKeown sees Pentecost as an inspiration for us today. We have reached a point in our diocese where the reality of smaller congregations and fewer priests mean we have to start doing things differently. But under the guidance of the Holy Spirit this is an opportunity for us to go out and share the Gospel, rebuild God's Church, and make our parishes more welcoming and inclusive. This is what the diocesan Pathways to the Future programme is all about, and this weekend we entrust that programme to the blessing of the Father, Son and Holy Spirit.
