The Ascension is only the first of several great feasts this month. Next Sunday we will celebrate the coming of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost. Then comes our own parish bicentenary on June 13th when Bishop Alan will come to give thanks to God for two hundred years of faith in Ballymoney and Derrykeighan. On Sunday June 22nd we



celebrate Corpus Christi with a traditional outdoor procession. On June 29th we mark the feast of Ss Peter and Paul and have our annual blessing of graves. The whole of June, meanwhile, is dedicated to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. Let's take every opportunity this month to be part of the celebrations and to grow in holiness and in the love of God.
