COME AND TAKE THE FLESH OF CHRIST

Today we celebrate the feast of Corpus Christi, marvelling at the incredible gift Jesus has given us in the Eucharist. Here in Ireland, faith in the real presence has burned brightly for fifteen centuries. At the ancient monastery of Bangor in our own diocese the earliest known Eucharistic hymn, Venite Sancte Sumite (Come and take the flesh of Christ) was sung by saints and scholars. In times of persecution our own ancestors risked everything to attend Mass, understanding it as the source and summit of faith.

When we receive Holy Communion, we become walking tabernacles, carrying Christ into our homes, workplaces, and communities. The Eucharist transforms us - if we let it. We're called to become the real presence of Christ in our world.
