WEEKEND COURSE ON DEMENTIA

Many people living with dementia or caring for them feel as though they are alone. A weekend workshop called 'The Long Goodbye' is being run at Dromantine retreat centre which seeks to provide practical information and support for families dealing with this issue. We will explore each stage of the journey with dementia from a personal perspective and explain how best to offer support to ensure the best quality of life for the person living with dementia and the people around them.

The course will be led by Father Hugh Lagan SMA Fr Lagan is a priest with the Society of African Missions and a chartered clinical psychologist. He has led retreats, workshops and trainings internationally on psychological and spiritual well-being, positive change, trauma, mental health and resilience.
