STEP OUT IN FAITH

What would you do if someone told you to pack your bags and follow them to an unknown destination? Most of us would politely decline! But not Abraham. When God called him in his old age, promising a homeland and descendants "like the stars in the sky," Abraham simply trusted and set out. That's what faith is - not just that we believe in God, but that we trust him with our lives!

Like Abraham in the second reading, we're called to step out in faith. Maybe God wants us to volunteer somewhere, reach out to someone lonely, or get more involved in our parish. In today's Gospel, Jesus reminds us that when he comes again he doesn't want to find us sitting around waiting for others to do the work. What leap of faith is God calling you to take today?


