SUFFERING FOR THE FAITH

In the readings this week we see how the message of God is often rejected. In the first reading the prophet Jeremiah is thrown down a well by God's enemies. And in the Gospel Jesus warns us that his coming sometimes bring division and suffering, just as Jesus himself would suffer and die on the cross.

In the centuries since countless Christians facing persecution and death for their beliefs have been consoled by these words. One of them was St Maximilian Kolbe, the martyr of Auschwitz, who was killed by the Nazis on 14th August 1941, the day before Our Lady's Assumption. Saints like these are a great source of inspiration and hope for us today.
