IESUS TEACHES US A LESSON

Jesus doesn't sound like himself in today's Gospel. He seems reluctant to help the Canaanite woman because she isn't a Jew and she has to persuade him to heal her daughter. But what's really going on here is that Jesus is teaching his apostles - and us as well - to avoid prejudice and be open to people of all nations.

Once we realise the lesson Jesus is trying to teach us we then have to put it into practice for ourselves. We live in a world where there is much division and bigotry. What Jesus wants is that we Catholics should be open-minded, kind and welcoming to others. He wants us to speak up for those who face discrimination. And he wants us to see others as our sisters and brothers in the faith.
