WHO IS JESUS... AND WHO ARE WE?

In today's Gospel Jesus asks his apostles a crucial question - "who do you say I am?". He's already heard how other people think he's John the Baptist or Elijah. They know he's someone important but they're not entirely sure who. But what about his close friends, do they know who he really is? It's Peter who answers and he knows that Jesus is the Son of God. Jesus responds to this by telling Peter who he is and what he will be the rock on which the Church is built.

Each of us has to answer this question for ourselves - who do we think Jesus really is? And if we know in our hearts that he is the Son of God and the Saviour of the World then he in turn will help us discover our own vocation in life. Like St Peter, God is calling each of us to be a great saint who makes the world a better place.
