

# POOR ST PETER!

For the man chosen to be the first leader of the Church poor St Peter sure made a lot of mistakes! Today's Gospel sees him trying to correct Jesus and being called Satan for his trouble. And that was only one of the times that Peter did the wrong thing. Think of his denial of Jesus on Good Friday or the story of quo vadis when Peter made to flee Rome during the persecutions of the emperor Nero.

But even though he slipped up a lot Peter always returned to the right path, with Jesus forgiving and guiding him. Peter's mistakes make him relatable, and he sets an example of having the humility to admit errors and get back on track. We should emulate St Peter when we falter or take the easy way out, think of him, seek Jesus' forgiveness, and turn round to follow God's will once more. Like Peter, we make mistakes, but through faith in Christ we can find our way again.
