GOD'S WAY OF COMPLAINING

In our readings today, we're reminded how to make complaints in a loving, Christian manner. In the first reading the Lord appointed Ezekiel to speak out against sin, even if it felt fruitless, because it was his sacred duty. In the same spirit, we too can stand up and complain about injustice and unfairness because it's the right thing to do.

But how should we deal with other people who have upset us? In the Gospel Jesus advises first discussing it calmly, one-on-one. If that doesn't work, bring along a mediator to help find common ground. And although this may not work immediately we should still be open to a future reconciliation. When we have grievances, let's seek fairness not revenge. Rather than arguing to win, let's aim to rebuild friendships. With patience and respect, even difficult people can have a change of heart. God can help us forgive those who've hurt us, and soften hard hearts through our gentle Christlike love.
