GOD IS MERCIFUL

The message of God's forgiveness is one that we are familiar with, but Jesus still wishes to emphasise it in the Gospel today. Our human approach to forgiveness is so often flawed - we hold grudges, erect barriers, make demands and establish conditions. Jesus wants to remind his listeners (and us) that God's forgiveness is overflowing and bountiful.

Saint Paul in the Second Reading shows he was well aware of this: he had persecuted the Church, calling himself the greatest of sinners; and yet, thanks to the inexhaustible patience of God, he can count himself a believer. We must be open to the gift of forgiveness for ourselves, and also open to that forgiveness offered to other whom we would condemn.
