Twenty Fourth Sunday of Ordinary Time



THE POWER OF FORGIVENESS

Today's Gospel parable calls us to forgiveness. A king forgives his servant's large debt when the servant begs for mercy. But the servant then refuses to forgive a much smaller debt owed to him. Jesus wants us to see ourselves in both these roles - we have been forgiven much by God, but we often refuse to forgive others over smaller offences.

Forgiveness is difficult as it requires letting go of anger. We struggle to forgive those who've deeply hurt us. But holding onto bitterness harms our souls and distances us from God who freely forgives our sins. We're called to show compassion and reconcile, not retaliate. The parable reminds us that we all rely completely on God's mercy, so must extend mercy to others. This coming week may our hearts be open to forgive, showing patience and kindness to those who wrong us. Choosing forgiveness frees us and builds God's kingdom of love
