Its repetitive nature quiets our minds, while meditating on the mysteries draws us closer to Jesus and Mary. This month our parish will hold weekly candlelight rosaries with scripture readings to illuminate the mysteries.

But there are other ways to pray too! This Sunday we begin a monthly bible prayer group to help us listen to how God speaks through scripture. And we'll restart our popular First Friday devotion - going to confession, Mass, and adoration monthly for nine months.

With chillier weather keeping us indoors, autumn invites us inward as well to strengthen our connection to God through heartfelt and meditative prayer. This October, deepen your prayer life and feel God's presence grow.
