JESUS GIVES US A WARNING

In today's Gospel, Jesus tells a parable comparing the Jewish leaders to vineyard workers who disrespect and kill the landowner's representatives. Finally the owner sends his son, but the workers kill him too.

This parable warns the chief priests and elders that though they are God's chosen people, they are often ungrateful, selfish, and hypocritical. In the Old Testament God sent them prophets but the leaders rejected them. Now God has sent his Son Jesus, but the leaders are jealous and plotting to kill him. They just won't listen to the warnings God is giving them.

We too can be defensive when Jesus warns us that there are consequences to breaking God's laws. But he warns us out of love, not to control us. If we ignore his teachings, we risk missing out on heaven. Let us open our hearts to his loving warnings for our own good.

THE MONTH OF THE ROSARY

October is the month of special devotion to the rosary. This prayer gives us an opportunity to spend ten minutes or so meditating on the mysteries of the lives of Jesus and Mary. The rosary has historically been especially popular in Ireland for families to pray together. Why not take the opportunity to pray it this month?

Some people pray the rosary every day and follow the weekly pattern -

Mondays & Saturdays - the Joyful Mysteries Tuesdays & Fridays - the Sorrowful Mysteries Thursdays - the Luminous Mysteries (mysteries of light) Wednesdays & Sundays - the Glorious Mysteries

Alternatively we might want to focus this week on just the Luminous mysteries:

1 The Baptism in the Jordan (Matthew 3: 13-17)

- 2 The Wedding at Cana (John 2: 1-12)
- 3 The Proclamation of the Kingdom of Heaven (Mark 1:15)
- 4 The Transfiguration (Luke 9: 28-35)
- 5 The Institution of the Eucharist (Mark 14: 22-25)
