# REMEMBERING THE DEAD IN NOVEMBER

This week the clocks go back, the nights get darker and we move in to November. For the Church this month is a time of special prayer for those who have died. Beginning with All Saints and All Souls this week we are encouraged to pray for the dead, to remember them at Mass, to visit the cemetery and to do penance for the Holy Souls in purgatory.

In the Gospel today we find Zacchaeus ready to do penance for his sins. Having defrauded and exploited others he now offers to repay them four times as much! Doing penance and making up for our mistakes is a natural part of saying sorry. And Jesus allows us to join him in doing penance for others as well. Just making a small sacrifice here and there can be a source of blessing for people who maybe don't pray for themselves. They also help our loved ones who have died move swiftly into heaven.
