THREE WARNINGS FROM JESUS

In the Gospel this Sunday, the Lord tells a parable about what sounds like a very strange wedding. In fact, this story is an accurate description of how marriages took place in the Holy Land at that time. But that's not why Jesus tells this tale. He wants us to give us three warnings we need to know if we're serious about going to heaven when we die.

Firstly, we do not know the day or the hour when Jesus will come for us. None of us can know when our lives will end or when will be the Last Day. That's because God doesn't want us to be scared of the future but to focus on being the best people we can be right now. So let's use the time we have well. Secondly, when our time comes we will be held accountable. It will be too late to change then! Thirdly, there are some things that others can't supply for uslike our faith, love, or a good character. We are personally responsible for the way we live our lives, and one day we will be judged for it too.
