TIME, TALENTS AND TREASURE

In this Sunday's Gospel Jesus uses the parable of the talents to explain one of the ways that we will be judged by God at the end of our lives - how did we use the gifts God has given us? In the parable he tells of a great king who gives his servants sums of money to see what they will do with them. Two of them use them well, investing and speculating so that they double their fortune. But the other buried his gifts and did nothing, and while his colleagues were rewarded, he was punished.

God gives us all gifts of time, talents and treasure to bless us at different times of our lives. But he wants us to use them well, not only so that we can profit from them but so that we can share them with others. We can afford to be generous with the good things God gave us, because his love and his blessings never run out. Let's ask the Lord to help us use our talents, time and treasure well.

It is with great sorrow that the Diocese has announced the death of the Most Rev. Anthony Farquhar on Friday. Bishop Farguhar served as auxiliary bishop of Down & Connor from 1983. He had previously been a teacher at Garron Tower and chaplain to both QUB and the University of Ulster in Coleraine along with Dominican College in Portstewart. May he rest in peace.
