CHRIST IS OUR KING

This weekend we mark the last Sunday of the Church's year - the feast of Jesus Christ, the Universal King. We celebrate that Jesus is our Saviour and Redeemer, and we pledge ourselves to serve him all our lives with love and faithfulness.

But what sort of king is Jesus Christ? The Gospel for this Sunday shows someone very different from the kings and tyrants of history, or even the prime ministers, presidents and politicians of today. Jesus is a king who came to serve, not to be served. On Calvary his crown was made of thorns, his throne was a cross. But from that cross he saved the world. May we never be ashamed of Christ our King - instead may we follow him loyally and say with confidence "Jesus, remember me when you come into your kingdom."
