Our activities this year

- In 2022 our conference provided Christmas Toy & Gift Vouchers to 56 children up to 16 years of age.
- Our annual outing for Senior Citizens and those living alone in September was to Templepatrick Garden Centre and then to the Hedges Hotel for a carvery meal. A great time was had by all.
- In the last 12 months we made over 200 home visitations to over 160 different households, almost half of those we visited had called SVP for the first time reflecting the increased demand for our service.
