O COME, O COME EMMANUEL

In today's Gospel, Joseph faces an impossible situation. But the answer comes when he stops and listens to God in silence. As he dreams, the angel tells Joseph that Mary's child will be the long awaited messiah, the *Emmanuel* – the one who is "God with us." Joseph listened, and he acted in faith.

For us this is the busiest week of the year - there are presents to wrap, people to see, sprouts to boil. We run the risk of celebrating "God with us" while being too busy to be with God! That's why our Advent challenge is to spend ten minutes in silence with Jesus each day. Not praying a list, not thinking of something else, just being present. *Emmanuel* means God wants to be with you – right now, in the chaos. Let's be with him too.
