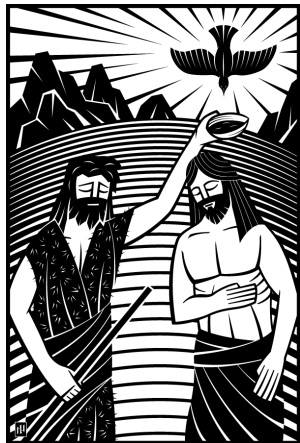

THE BAPTISM OF JESUS

Today we celebrate the final feast of the Christmas season, marking the moment when Jesus began his public mission at age thirty. When he was baptised in the Jordan, heaven opened, the Spirit descended, and the Father's voice confirmed that Jesus is the Son of God. This event launched three years of teaching, healing, and proclaiming God's kingdom.

Christ's baptism connects directly to our own. Through baptism, we share in Jesus' life and mission. As we journey through the new year ahead, hearing about Jesus feeding the hungry, healing the sick, and forgiving sinners, he calls us to join in this same work. Our baptism wasn't just a ceremony—it's an ongoing invitation to help save the world with Christ.
