November – month of the Holy Souls

November is traditionally a time of special prayer for our loved ones who have died. The parish will mark it in several ways:

❖ **All Souls' Day – Saturday November 2nd**

This is not a holy day of obligation but many people choose to come to Mass to pray for the dead. Special Masses at: 9am (Dervock) and 11am (Ballymoney).

❖ **November Dead Lists**

Dead lists and envelopes are available in both churches. Please take one home and write the names of those you wish to have remembered. The lists will be placed before the altar and prayed for at every Mass from All Souls' until the end of the month. You may wish to include an offering in the envelope and these are gratefully received.

❖ **Plenary Indulgence for the Holy Souls**

We can gain an indulgence for the Holy Souls by visiting the church on Friday 1st or by visiting a cemetery from 1st-8th November. The usual conditions apply – that we receive Communion and go to Confession (within 20 days either side), and pray for the Pope's intentions.

❖ **Mass for deceased parishioners**

A special requiem Mass for all our deceased parishioners will be celebrated on Friday 15th November at 7.30pm.
