 where a container will be placed before the service begins.
 Please leave the names of those who have been buried in
 our Graveyard since last Cemetery Sunday into the
 parochial house. At this time we remember especially
 those whose burial places are unmarked and unknown but
 not forgotten and who are commemorated with a memorial
 in the old cemetery.

Parking will be available in the school grounds
 When parking remember to do so responsibly respecting
 the needs of others, and **DO NOT** create any obstruction or
 block any route that may be required by the emergency
 services.

A collection will be taken up to help defray the cost of
 maintaining the cemetery.
