This miraculous 54-day Rosary Novena was given to the world on March 3, 1884 when Our Lady of Pompeii appeared to a gravely ill Italian girl, called Fortuna Agrelli.

We invite you to pray the 54-day Rosary Novena for the following intention:

"That Ireland as a Nation, will uphold the Sanctity of Marriage between a man and a woman in the upcoming Referendum."

How to make the Rosary Novena:

The rosary novena is made by praying a 5-decade rosary for 54 consecutive days (for this important intention).

Calendar Showing 54-day Rosary Novena Period

[⊕] The first 27 days are said in Petition, and will commence on **St. Patrick's Day** (Tuesday 17th March) and end on the **Feast of Divine Mercy** (Sunday 12th April).

† The second 27 days are said in thanksgiving, and commence on the Monday 13th April, after Divine Mercy Sunday, Day and end on Saturday 9th May.

<u>Please Note</u>: the Novena of Thanksgiving is prayed even if the answer to your intention was not yet given. In other words, during the second 27 days you are giving thanks that God's will is going to be done. The day-to-day rosary meditations are in accordance with the guidelines set out in the Joyful, Sorrowful, Glorious and Mysteries of Light.

As well as the aforementioned points, here are some others to guide you when praying this 54-day Rosary Novena:

- You do not have to pray an extra Rosary, but include this important intention in the rosary you already say, ie. pray the Rosary you normally would and mention this petition each day.
- If possible, offer this intention at daily Mass.
- <u>Join us any time</u>: if you are reading this after the novena has begun, then please feel free to begin the 54-day Rosary Novena at any time.
